### Liturgy of the word

**Psalm 105.1-6, 37-45: *Confitemini Domino***

1 Give thanks to the Lord and call up<sup>on</sup> his name; /  
**make known his deeds a-mong** the peo-ples.  
2 **Sing to him, sing prais-es to him, /**  
**and speak of all his mar-vel-lous works.**  
3 Glory in his<sup>ho-ly</sup> name; /  
let the hearts of those who seek the Lord<sup>re-joice</sup>.  
4 **Search for the Lord and his strength; /**  
**con-tin-ual<sup>ly</sup> seek<sup>his</sup> face.**  
5 Remember the mar-vels<sup>he</sup> has done, /  
his wonders and the judge-ments of<sup>his</sup> mouth,
