and vowed a vow to the Mighty One of Ja-cob.**
- 3 "I will not come under the roof of my<sup>^</sup>house, /  
nor climb up in-to my<sup>^</sup>bed;
- 4 **I will not allow my eyes to<sup>^</sup>sleep, /  
nor let my eye-lids slum-ber;**
- 5 Until I find a place for the<sup>^</sup>Lord, /  
a dwelling for the Mighty One of Ja-cob."
- 6 **"The ark! We heard it was in E-phra<sup>^</sup>-tah; /  
we found it in the fields of Jea-rim.**
- 7 Let us go to God's dwell-ing<sup>^</sup>place; /  
let us fall upon our knees be-fore his foot-stool."
- 8 **Arise, O Lord, into your rest-ing<sup>^</sup>place, /  
you and the ark of your strength.**
- 9 Let your priests be clothed with righ-teous<sup>^</sup>-ness; /  
let your faithful peo-ple sing with<sup>^</sup>joy.
- 10 **For your servant Da-vid's<sup>^</sup>sake, /  
do not turn away the face of your A-noint-ed.**
- 11 The Lord has sworn an oath to Da-vid; /  
in truth, he will not break it:

- 12 **"A son, the fruit of your bo-dy /  
will I set up-on your<sup>^</sup>throne.**
- 13 If your children keep my covenant  
and my testimonies that I shall teach them, /  
their children will sit upon your throne for ev-er<sup>^</sup>-more."
- 14 **For the Lord has chosen Zi-on; /  
he has desired her for his ha-bi-ta-tion:**
- 15 "This shall be my resting-place for ev-er; /  
here will I dwell, for I de-light in<sup>^</sup>her.
- 16 **I will surely bless her pro-vi-sions, /  
and satis-fy her poor with<sup>^</sup>bread.**
- 17 I will clothe her priests with sal-va-tion, /  
and her faithful people will re-joyce and<sup>^</sup>sing.
- 18 **There will I make the horn of David flour-ish; /  
I have prepared a lamp for my A-noint-ed.**
- 19 As for his enemies, I will clothe them with<sup>^</sup>shame; /  
**but as for him, his crown will<sup>^</sup>shine.**
