### Liturgy of the word

**Old Testament Lesson:** Isaiah 49.1-7

**Psalm 40.1-14:** *Expectans expectavi*

- 1 I WAIT-ed patiently for the Lord, /  
and he inclined unto me, and heard my cäll-ing.
- 2 He brought me also out of the horrible pit,  
out of the mire and clay, /  
and set my feet upon the rock, and ordered my gö-ings.
- 3 And he hath put a new song in my mouth, /  
even a thanksgiving unto öür God.
- 4 Many shall see it and fear, /  
and shall put their trust in thē Lord.
- 5 Blessed is the man that hath set his hope in the Lord, /  
and turned not unto the proud,  
and to such as go a-böut with lies.
- 6 O Lord my God, many are the wondrous works  
which thou hast dōne,  
like as be also thy thoughts which are to us-ward; /  
and there is none to be compared ün-to thee.

- 7 If I should declare them and **speak** of them, /  
they should be more than I am able tō ex<sup>^</sup>press.
- 8 **Sacrifice and offering thou would-est not, /  
but mine ears hast thou ö-pen<sup>^</sup>ed.**
- 9 Burnt offering and sacrifice for sin hast thou **not** re-quir-ed; /  
then said I, “Lö, I<sup>^</sup>come;
- 10 **In the volume of the book it is written of mē;  
I delight to fulfil thy will, O my God; /  
yea, thy law is with-in my<sup>^</sup>heart.”**
- 11 I have declared thy righteousness in the great con-gre-ga-tion; /  
lo, I will not refrain my lips, O Lord, and that thou knōw-est.
- 12 **I have not hid thy righteousness with-in my heart; /  
my talk hath been of thy truth and of thy sal-vā-tion.**
- 13 I have not kept back thy loving mer-cy and truth /  
from the great congre-gä-tion.
- 14 **Withdraw not thou thy mercies from me, O Lord; /  
let thy loving-kindness and thy truth always pre-sērve me.**
