

1 LIKE AS the hart desir-eth the wa-ter-brooks, /  
so longeth my soul af-ter thee, O God.

2 My soul is athirst for God, yea, even for the liv-ing God: /  
when shall I come to appear before the pre-sence of God?

3 My tears have been my food day and night, /  
while all day long they say unto me, "Where is now thy God?"

4 These things will I remember as I pour out my soul with-  
in me: / how I went with the multitude, and brought them  
forth into the house of God,

5 With the voice of praise and thanks-giv-ing, /  
a multitude keep-ing ho-ly day.

6 Why art thou so full of heav-i-ness, O my soul? /  
and why art thou so disquieted with-in me?
